December 19-December 23, 2005	Winter solstice-wear pajamas for the shortest day of the year.

January 2- January 6, 2006	Season of Winter –weather, animals, people (White-review) (Hot/Cold)
January 9-January 13, 2006	Janubeary (Black) (In/Out)
January 16-January 27, 2006	(2 weeks) Martin Luther King Junior, Nursery Rhymes (Purple) (Under/Over)
January 30-February 3, 2006	Groundhog Day, Healthy Bodies (Top/Bottom)
February 6-February 17, 2006	(2 weeks) Senses, Valentines Day, (Heart shape) (High/Low pitch) (Loud/Soft)
February 20-February 24, 2006	Opposites , Presidents' Day (Star shape)
February 27-March 3, 2005	Dinosaurs, Volcanoes (Carnivore/Herbivore/Omnivore)
March 6- March 10, 2006	Review of Colors (Red, Blue, Yellow, Orange, Purple)
March 13-March 17, 2006	(St. Patrick's Day, Green, Shapes-circle, triangle, square, rectangle, shamrock)
March 20-March 24, 2006	Season of Spring-Weather (Gray-nimbus clouds (mix black/white))

April 3-April 7, 2006	Birds (Chickens, Ducks, Owl, Robin) and (Oval shape) (Long/Short)
April 10-April 14, 2006	Insects with Eric Carle (Many/Few) (Counting with one to one correspondence)
April 17-April 21, 2006	Watch caterpillars go through their life cycle and turn into butterflies, read the very hungry caterpillar by Eric Carle /Earth Day (Big/Little)
April 24-April 28, 2006	Let us make a colorful garden, planting sunflower seeds.
May 1-May 5, 2006	May Day, Planting a vegetable garden, bean seeds, Jack and the beanstalk (Mother's Day)
May 8-May 12, 2006	Health and Nutrition-food groups-plants/animal foods- (More/Less) (Sorting)
