We are excited to launch plans for Week 11. There are some great options for physical activities in an indoor environment. Additionally, some simple ideas with materials available at home to support the creative undertakings. We hope you enjoy this week's plan with your little ones!

STEAM

Science, Technology, Engineering, Art
and Mathematics

Hurricane Engineering:

Build a structure using a variety of materials. Test out your structures in front a fan to see if they stay standing. If their structure does not hold up, how can they make it stronger? Materials that can be used a popsicle sticks, playdough, toothpicks, mini marshmallows, construction paper, cardboard, straws, tape.



Science Experiment

Rain Storm

You will need water, shaving cream, food coloring, clear container and eye droppers. Put water into the clear container and spray shaving cream on top of it. Have your child predict what will happen when you drop food coloring onto the shaving cream. Add food coloring to a cup of water then use an eye dropper to drip food coloring onto the shaving cream and watch what happens.



Physical Literacy

Balloon Volleyball

Using a balloon and a net, play in a game of volleyball with your child. If you do not have a net at your house, you can use string or yarn to make one.



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Sensory



Rainbow Soap Foam

In a bowl, add $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water, 2 tbsp dish soap, and food coloring. Using a hand mixer, Kitchen Aid mixer or a whisk, mix the water and soap until foam is formed. Add to a bin for your child to explore with. Use the recipe to make different colors to make rainbow foam.

Creative Activity

Puffy Paint Clouds

You will need some construction paper, shaving cream, white glue, a spoon, bowl and cotton balls or sponges. Start by mixing your paint – I used $\frac{3}{4}$ cup shaving cream to a $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of glue. Dip your cotton balls in the paint. Print it on your paper. Let dry- the paint will dry puffy!



Additional Activities

Fruit Kabobs: Cut up various fruit and place on kabob sticks. Have your child make patterns with their fruits to add math to this culinary activity.

Rainbow Milk Toast: Mix food coloring with a little sweetened condensed milk. Let your child paint pictures on their bread using the colored sweetened condensed milk. Dab with a paper towel before adding to toaster.

Rainbow Poems: Using the colors of the rainbow, have your child write about what the colors taste, smell, look, or sound like. Let them be creative in their writing.
