Dear Families,

We are excited to launch plans for Week 14. There are some great options for physical activities in an indoor environment. Additionally, some simple ideas with materials available at home to support the creative undertakings. We hope you enjoy this week's plan with your little ones!

Language Development

Ocean Animals

Talk with your child about what animals live in the ocean. Make a list of all the ocean animals. Have your child pick out their favorite ocean animal to draw and help them write the name of the animal.



Social-Emotional Development

Ice Cream Stand

Set up and run a pretend ice cream stand with your child. You can use pom poms or crumbled paper for ice cream, an ice cream scoop, paper cones and bowls. Take turns with your child on running the ice cream stand. Encourage your child to say please and thank you when they are asking for some ice cream.



Physical Literacy

Beach Towel Ball Toss

You will need a beach towel (or a kitchen towel) and a beach ball for this activity. Let your child hold the towel and try to toss and catch the ball with the towel instead of their hands.

Cognitive Development

Pool Noodle Building

Cut pool noodles up into 1 inch circles. Let your child use the pool noodle circles and some shaving cream to build a tower. Use the shaving cream to stick the pool noodles together.

Creative Activity

Paper Plate Seashells

Let your child cut the shape of a seashell out of a paper plate. Have them paint the seashell using water and food coloring paint.



Additional Activities

Ocean Animal Play Dough Creations: Encourage your child to sculpt their favorite ocean animal out of playdough.

Sand Foam: Make sand foam using 3 cups of sand and 1 can of shaving cream. Mix the two ingredients together. Add trucks, cars, and other sand toys for exploration.

Sand I-Spy: Hide items in the bottom of a bin. Add sand to cover the items. Play an I-Spy game with your child and have them search the sand for the different items.
