

LEARNING AT HOME OLDER TODDLER WEEK 23

August 24th-August 28th



Dear Families,

We are excited to launch plans for Week 23. There are some great options for physical activities in an indoor environment. Additionally, some simple ideas with materials available at home to support the creative undertakings. We hope you enjoy this week's plan with your little ones!

Language Development

Safety

Talk with your toddler about staying safe. What do we need to do when we keep our bodies safe while at home? Talk about house rules (walking feet, inside voices, cleaning up) that you have and how they keep them safe.



Social-Emotional Development

Turn Taking

While playing with your toddler, practice taking turns and sharing with each other. Practice manners when asking for a toy by modeling the words to use.



Physical Literacy

Soccer

Practice soccer skills by kicking a ball back and forth with your child. Encourage them to run to the ball and kick it.



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Cognitive Development

Sorting Toys

Put out toys that your child can sort by color. Help them sort the toys by pointing out the colors and asking them where you should put it. You can put out colored construction paper to help them learn when to put the colored toys.



Creative Activity

Painting with different tools

Provide your child with paint and painting tools. Let your child paint with paintbrushes, rollers, sponges, their fingers or feathers.



Additional Activities

Felt Faces: Make facial features out of felt. Let your child make faces by putting the facial features on a piece of felt. Encourage them to try out different faces and get silly.

Follow the Leader: Play follow the leader with your toddler. Encourage them to practice walking, running, hopping, skipping, and jumping around the yard. You can also work on climbing skills if you have play structures or stairs they can climb.

I-Spy Sensory: Hide items in a bin of sand or rice. Encourage your child to find the different items and show you. You can ask them to find items, colors or shapes in the bin.
