We are excited to launch plans for Week 9. There are some great options for physical activities in an indoor environment. Additionally, some simple ideas with materials available at home to support the creative undertakings. We hope you enjoy this week's plan with your little ones!

Language Development

Snow Song

Sing the snow song with your infant. Provide them with instruments and snowballs to use. Snow Song: (To the tune of London Bridge)- See the snow falling down, Falling down, falling down, See the snow falling down, It is snowy.



Social-Emotional Development

Peek-a-boo

Play peek-a-boo with your infant. Bring their attention to their reaction and how they might be feeling while playing and interacting with you.



Physical Literacy

Snowball Drop

Provide your infant with fake snowballs (rolled socks or crumbled paper works as well) and a bucket. Encourage them to pick up the snowballs and put them in the bucket. Let them dump the bucket and start again.

Cognitive Development

Tissue Box Discovery

Provide your infant with an empty tissue box. Hide objects or toys in the box for them to feel and pull out.

Bring their attention to the item when they are able to pull it out and name that item.

Creative Activity

Painting with Water

Provide your infant with a paintbrush, water, and colored paper. Let your infant paint with the water. Bring their attention to the marks the water leaves behind.



Additional Activities

Snow Hide and Seek: Place toys of interest under a piece of white fabric or felt. Encourage your infant to lift the fabric to reveal the toy.

Paint Exploration: Provide your infant with taste safe white paint and colored paper. Let your infant paint with the white paint snow. **Yogurt Paint:** Provide your infant with white yogurt to paint with.
